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# **OFFICIAL 2021 3rd OF JULY PARADE RULES**

Entrants are reminded that this parade is a new and fun event celebrating the spirit of Independence Day. Each entry must be entertaining, energetic, and original. Each entry **MUST** be Patriotic themed!

## **\*\*PLEASE RESPECT SOCIAL DISTANCING RULES REGARDING COVID\*\***

1. The primary contact/applicant shall be responsible for the conduct of all of its participants and agrees to notify ALL participants of these rules and regulations. Primary contact is IN CHARGE of the entry from date of acceptance until the end of the parade – be sure you are ready for this BIG JOB!!!!
2. Parade entry registration shall only be accepted in writing via a completed Official 2021 Parade Entry Registration Form. Entry deadline is July 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021. No late registrations are accepted.
3. Parade participants are strictly prohibited from participating in any form of political campaigning in conjunction with the 2021 Parade, including but not limited to the display of any political campaign signs, buttons, t-shirts and literature. We believe in voting, we simply don't want our event to become a political platform!!!
4. Every entry must have a patriotic theme. Entrants that do not observe the theme will not be allowed to participate in the parade. Keep your entry fun and entertaining for the gathered crowd!!!
5. If your approved entry has music you will play, please provide it yourself and play at a level that won't distract from surrounding entries. No profanity please!
6. Each motorized entry may have no more than 10 walkers with their entry. All walkers must follow the patriotic theme!!! The number of riders on each motorized entry is up to the applicant but must follow current motorized vehicle laws. All riding participants must be part of the theme of the entry – they must be critical to theme of the float/entry. Riding participants will not be permitted to jump off and on units/entries while the parade is in progress. Those on the float or vehicle must remain on the float or vehicle. Those on the ground must remain on the ground. If a City Official feels a participant is riding in an unsafe manner or on an unsafe location on the float or vehicle, the participant must move from that location or risk being ineligible for future parade participation. Please obey the City Officials – we are all about SAFETY FIRST!
7. Vehicles not pulling floats must pass strict guidelines for inclusion in the parade, PLEASE NOTE THAT MOTORIZED ENTRIES SHOULD MAINTAIN A STEADY RATE OF SPEED OF 5MPH throughout the parade. No gunning of engines, sudden accelerations, etc.
8. All group entries not on a float should be preceded by a banner, carried by at least two people, announcing the name of group.
9. No unit whose sole purpose is for advertising will be allowed to participate in the parade.
10. Entry Number Information and Parade Map will be given to you when you line up. All other correspondence will be done by e-mail. Please make sure your e-mail address is legible on your application.
11. Drivers and all vehicles participating in the parade must have insurance as required by the State of Washington. Drivers must also possess a valid driver's license. Drivers **MUST NOT** toss items from their vehicle – their job is to drive, not to throw beads or other items.
12. Owner must follow up with their vehicle's manufacturer to confirm that the vehicle entered in the parade has not been identified to have mechanical defects. The owner warrants that the vehicle is in sound mechanical condition with no known defects or safety concerns.
13. Volunteers will be on duty in the staging area as well as at various locations along the parade route to insure the smooth and orderly progression of the set up and of the parade itself. City Officials will have the authority to remove any unit (entry) causing a delay, violating official parade rules, or failing to cooperate. If you refuse to move along as directed by the officials, you risk becoming ineligible to participate in future parades. Please be cooperative!
14. Parade line-up and staging will open at 8am, Saturday July 3<sup>rd</sup>, at the ball fields. All must be in position in their assigned spaces and ready by 8:45am.

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15. All entries must check-in upon arrival with Deanna Syron, and be directed to their assigned staging area. All entries must keep a representative with the entry at all times within the assigned staging area. Only those vehicles actually in the parade are allowed in the staging area!!
  16. Parade will promptly begin at 9am from the staging area described above.
  17. Any approved entry that must cancel their participation in the parade, must contact Deanna Syron as soon as possible so that line-up changes may be handled promptly. She can be reached at 360-949-3347.
  18. The use prior to and/or possession during the parade of any alcoholic beverage or illegal substance, by any unit/entry member, is strictly forbidden. If a City Official observes behavior that may be related to alcohol or drug consumption, that affected entry will be disqualified from participation in the parade.
  19. Under no circumstances shall any participant, unit or entry move to a different position within the parade line-up, before or during the parade, except under the direction of Deanna Syron or other City Official
  20. Proper unit spacing and parade pace is critical. Parade speed will maintain at no more than 5mph and approximately four (4) feet per second. Voluntary stopping for any entry cannot exceed 45 seconds.
  21. Participants riding in vehicles or trailers must provide their own vehicles and drivers. Insurance and liability are the sole responsibility of participants.
  26. Support vehicles for non-motorized entries will **not** be allowed in the parade.
  27. Parade participants are expected to conduct themselves in a courteous and safe manner.
  28. Drivers of vehicles **MAY NOT TOSS** candy/beads or other items. Safety is a priority – drivers must concentrate only on driving!!! Candy/beads may be **SAFELY** given or tossed by someone other than the driver (**NEVER THROWN OVERHAND**) to the parade spectators.  
Any participants caught throwing candy or objects in the intent to harm any person or group, will be asked to exit the parade and will disqualify their entry from the parade contest. **DO NOT THROW HEAVY ITEMS THAT COULD POTENTIALLY HURT A SPECTATOR.**
  29. These rules are subject to change on short notice. Advance notice will be given appropriately. Failure to comply with the parade rules will result in an entry member or entire entry group's removal from the parade (even if in progress) and/or future participation banning.
  30. Failure to follow the 2021 rules may cause exclusion from participation in all future parades.
  31. **MOST IMPORTANT RULE – HAVE FUN!!!!**
